Begin at the edge of one of the world's greatest natural wonders — **Victoria Falls**, known in the local Tonga language as Mosi-oa-Tunya, the smoke that thunders.

Three nights at Insika Lodge place you at the doorstep of this UNESCO World Heritage Site, with a full programme of iconic experiences: a guided tour of the falls, a 2-course lunch at the celebrated Lookout Café, a sunset river cruise on the Zambezi, a township tour, and a memorable dinner aboard the historic Bushtracks Express train.

Then, a scenic charter flight carries you into the heart of **Hwange National Park** — Zimbabwe's largest game reserve, famed for its extraordinary elephant herds and prolific wildlife.

Four nights at Iganyana Tented Camp offer full board, twice-daily game activities, and a visit and contribution to the vital work of the Painted Dog Conservation Centre — all from a camp that places you deep in the wilderness where few roads and even fewer visitors venture.

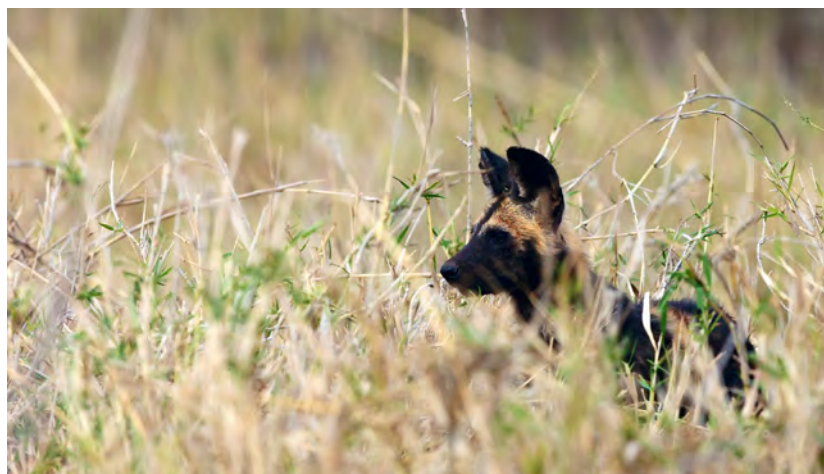
Some of the finest moments on safari happen over a fire, long after the game drive has ended — when strangers become fellow travellers, and fellow travellers become friends.

Insika Lodge

VICTORIA FALLS

Experience the perfect Zimbabwean journey at Insika Lodge, where African elegance meets natural serenity just 3.6 km from the Falls and moments from the National Park entrance. Spacious rooms, tranquil gardens, a spa, and a private waterhole that draws wildlife to the horizon pool.

ITINERARY

Three nights in Victoria Falls town, each day revealing a different face of one of Africa's most extraordinary destinations. You arrive to a night game drive and bush dinner at the Stanley & Livingstone estate — a generous opening act. Day two belongs to the falls themselves: a guided tour along the knife-edge of the gorge, lunch at Lookout Café with the chasm dropping away beneath the terrace, and a sunset cruise on the Zambezi as the light turns everything gold. The third day moves from the natural to the human — a township tour of the surrounding community, followed by a 5-course dinner aboard the Bushtracks Express, a restored historic train that rolls through the bush long after dark.

Iganyana Tented Camp

DETE VLEI, HWANGE

Your adventure continues at Iganyana Tented Camp in Hwange, set on a private concession bordering the national park and overlooking the ancient Dete Vlei, a natural wildlife corridor alive with elephants, antelope, and predators moving between waterholes.

This refined tented sanctuary blends simple luxury in the bush with sweeping views, generous tented suites, and personal hosting that makes every moment feel intimate and unforgettable.

ITINERARY

A charter flight from Victoria Falls delivers you to Iganyana's private concession on the border of Hwange National Park, where the Dete Vlei stretches out in front of camp and the wildlife moves through on its own terms. Four full days of morning and afternoon game drives follow on a concession shared with no one else — a night drive, a sundowner picnic set against an open Hwange horizon, and the particular stillness of a place that has no interest in hurrying you along.

5-COURSE DINNER ON THE BUSHTRACKS EXPRESS

A restored historic train, a candlelit table, the bush rolling past the windows. There is no other dinner quite like it.

GUIDED TOUR OF VICTORIA FALLS

More than a kilometre wide, a hundred metres deep and absolutely nothing prepares you for it.

NIGHT GAME DRIVE & BUSH DINNER — STANLEY & LIVINGSTONE

The bush after dark is a different country entirely — and dinner tastes better under a sky with no ceiling.

CHARTER FLIGHT - VICTORIA FALLS TO HWANGE

The landscape opens beneath you — dry riverbeds, mopane woodland, the slow geometry of elephant paths — and Hwange announces itself.

TOWNSHIP TOUR

The community around Victoria Falls is as rich a story as the falls themselves — this is where you hear it.

SUNSET RIVER CRUISE ON THE ZAMBEZI

The river turns gold, the hippos surface, and the day settles into something you won't want to end.

SUNDOWNER PICNIC IN THE BUSH

No camp, no walls, no roof — just the concession, the last of the light, and a sundowner that earns its name.

NIGHT DRIVE — HWANGE CONCESSION

When the guides cut the engine and listen, and the lamp swings slowly across the scrub, Hwange reveals what the daylight keeps to itself.

MORNING & AFTERNOON GAME DRIVES — PRIVATE CONCESSION

No other vehicles. No shared sightings. Just Iganyana's guides, the Dete Vlei, and whatever the day decides to offer.



Exploration Information

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Guests must be able to board light aircraft and safari vehicles unassisted and walk moderate distances over uneven terrain. Those with specific medical or mobility concerns are encouraged to contact us before booking.

CHARTER FLIGHTS

Flights operate on light aircraft and are subject to change due to weather or operational requirements. Aircraft type, routing, and scheduling may vary without prior notice.

COST INCLUDES

Three nights at Insika Lodge (bed and breakfast) and four nights at Iganyana Tented Camp (full board, local brand beverages and laundry); all activities and excursions listed in the itinerary; return shared road transfers between Victoria Falls Airport and Insika Lodge; shared charter flights between Victoria Falls and Hwange; all domestic airport taxes and fuel levies; Bushtracks VIP arrival service including bottled water and scented hand towels; park and conservation fees; portage at Victoria Falls Airport and Insika Lodge; a visit to and donation supporting the Painted Dog Conservation Centre; and a bush sundowner with canapés at Iganyana; Meals total 7 breakfasts, 5 lunches, 6 dinners and 1 sundowner drinks and canapés on the Zambezi river cruise.

COST DOES NOT INCLUDE

International or Regional commercial flights and airport taxes to and from Victoria Falls Airport; visas and travel documents; travel and medical insurance; gratuities; premium brand beverages; meals and beverages not specified under inclusions; optional activities not specified in the itinerary; and items of a personal nature.
