The Falls, The River, The Wild Heart of Africa



Few journeys in southern Africa offer this kind of contrast without ever feeling disjointed.

Three nights in Livingstone put you at the edge of one of the natural world's most overwhelming spectacles — **Victoria Falls** from the Zambian bank, white rhino on foot in Mosi-oa-Tunya, an elephant encounter at river level, a sunset drifting down the Zambezi, and a candlelit dinner on the Royal Livingstone Express long after the bush has gone dark.

Then the road crosses into Botswana, and **Chobe National Park** opens up — a different kind of wild, quieter and more expansive, where the game comes to the river and the days are shaped by boat cruises, long drives deep into the park, and the particular stillness of Tlouwana Tented Camp, a boutique canvas retreat that has no interest in hurrying you anywhere.

Two countries, seven nights, and a journey that understands exactly how to move between them.

DAY 1 - 3

Radisson Blu Mosi-Oa-Tunya

LIVINGSTONE, ZAMBIA

A well-appointed riverside base close to the spray of the Falls, with spacious rooms, attentive service, and easy access to the Zambian bank of the Victoria Falls — one of Africa's most overwhelming natural spectacles.

ITINERARY

Three nights in Livingstone, each day revealing a different face of one of Africa's most extraordinary destinations. The first belongs to the Falls — a guided tour along the Zambian bank, where the mist shifts and the gorge drops suddenly away beneath you. The second moves between land and water: white rhino on a morning walk in Mosi-oa-Tunya, an elephant encounter at river level with lunch, and a sunset cruise on the Zambezi as the light turns everything gold. The third takes you into the surrounding community before the journey ends at the table it deserves — a 5-course dinner aboard the Royal Livingstone Express, a restored historic train rolling over the tracks of the iconic Victoria Falls bridge at sunset.

DAY 4 - 8

Tlouwana Tented Camp

CHOBE, BOTSWANA

An intimate canvas camp on the edge of one of Africa's greatest wildlife destinations, where generous tents, personal hosting, and the rhythms of the Chobe River shape every day. Unhurried, unfenced, and entirely at home in the wild.

ITINERARY

A shared road transfer crosses the Kazungula Bridge into Botswana and delivers you to Tlouwana in time for the first activity of the afternoon. Four full days of exploration follow, each shaped by the season and whatever the park decides to offer. Game viewing river cruises put you at water level as hundreds of elephants cross; long drives push deep into the park in search of lion, leopard, and wild dog; night drives reveal what the daylight keeps to itself. A community tour and a bicycle ride through the Lesoma Valley round out a stay that manages to feel both full and unhurried. The Chobe rewards those who give it time — and Tlouwana gives you exactly that.

GUIDED TOUR OF VICTORIA FALLS — ZAMBIAN SIDE

The Zambian bank offers an intimacy the other side cannot — paths that wind close to the edge of the gorge, and a curtain of mist that shifts with the season and the hour.

WALKING WITH WHITE RHINO — MOSI-OA-TUNYA

On foot, at close range, with a species that was once gone from Zambia entirely. A quiet morning that stays with you long after the dust has settled.

ELEPHANT INTERACTION WITH LUNCH AND RIVER TRANSFERS

At river level, in the company of elephants raised with remarkable gentleness — and a lunch set in one of the most unexpected locations on the Zambezi.

SUNSET RIVER CRUISE — LADY LIVINGSTONE

The river turns gold, the hippos surface, and the day settles into something you won't want to end.

MUKUNI VILLAGE & MARAMBA MARKET

The community around Livingstone is as rich a story as the falls themselves — this is where you hear it.

5-COURSE DINNER ON THE ROYAL LIVINGSTONE EXPRESS

A restored historic train, a stop overlooking the Victoria Falls, the bush rolling past the windows. There is no other dinner quite like it.

BOAT CRUISE — CHOBE RIVER

The chobe at water level is a different experience entirely. Elephants cross in their hundreds, crocodiles surface, and the late afternoon light on the river is something cameras never quite manage to capture.

GAME DRIVES — CHOBE NATIONAL PARK

One of the highest concentrations of elephant on the continent, Chobe rewards patience with everything it has to offer.

Exploration Information

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Guests must be able to board light aircraft and safari vehicles unassisted and walk moderate distances over uneven terrain. Those with specific medical or mobility concerns are encouraged to contact us before booking.

COST INCLUDES

Three nights at Radisson Blu Hotel (bed and breakfast) and four nights at Tlouwana Tented Camp (full board, local brand beverages and laundry); all activities and excursions listed in the itinerary; shared road transfer from Livingstone Airport to the hotel on arrival; shared road transfer from the hotel to Tlouwana Tented Camp including border formalities and bridge levy; shared transfer from Tlouwana to Kasane Airport on departure; fuel levies; Bushtracks VIP arrival service including bottled water and scented hand towels; park and conservation fees throughout; portage at Livingstone Airport and hotel. Meals total 7 breakfasts, 5 lunches, 5 dinners, and 1 sundowner drinks and canapés on the Zambezi river cruise.

COST DOES NOT INCLUDE

International or regional commercial flights and airport taxes to and from Livingstone or Kasane Airports; visas and travel documents; travel and medical insurance; gratuities; premium brand beverages; meals and beverages not specified under inclusions; optional activities not listed in the itinerary; and items of a personal nature. This itinerary arrives into Livingstone and departs from Kasane. A return transfer to Livingstone can be arranged at additional cost if required.

GROUP SIZE & DEPARTURES

Minimum 2, maximum 8 guests. Departures not guaranteed below minimum — guests will be offered an alternative date or full refund. 2026 Departure Dates: 2 July, 23 July, 20 August, 22 October, 5 November, 19 November, 10 December
